
TESTING

CATCHING HEPATITIS B & LIVER CANCER EARLY IS IMPORTANTI PROTECT YOUR LIVER AND YOUR LIFE:	TESTING IS THE ONLY WAY TO KNOW IF YOU HAVE HEPATITIS B, WHICH CAN CAUSE LIVER CANCER. THE TEST FOR HEP B IS SIMPLE AND EASY AND CAN KEEP YOU AND YOU FAMILY HEALTHY. YOU ARE IN CONTROL! DONT WAIT UNTIL YOU FEEL SICK!	Esting may be scary, but it can offer you peace of mind and the chance to be around longer for your family and community members who love you.
People living with chronic hepatitis B infections should be regularly screened for liver cancer to allow for early detection. During pregnancy, if your doctor is aware that you have hepatitis B, he or she can ensure #hepB transmission to your baby is prevented by taking the right steps.


